INSIDE TORONTO PEARSON (YYZ)

Toronto Pearson International Maple Leaf Lounge

Located on Level 3 of Terminal 1, the 15,500 square-foot open-air mezzanine space seats 331 people. Inspired by the experience of walking through a park, the lounge features a teak-veneer backdrop punctuated by points of light in foliage patterns, a recessed water wall, stacked stone décor and woody enclosures. Customers can enjoy the full-service café and bar with complimentary alcoholic beverages and a rotating menu. The lounge also boasts a cell-free quiet zone with reclined seating and low-level floor lighting, a business zone in which seats are grouped in covered cabanas, high-speed Wi-Fi, a selection of national and international newspapers and magazines, and shower rooms.

Customers can enjoy the full-service café and bar with complimentary alcoholic beverages, including a selection of Canadian wines, and a buffet-style dining area with fresh, hearty and healthy meals and snacks. Located at gate 52, the two-floor 13,454 square-foot space was designed by Gustavson Wylie Architects and seats 258 customers. The lounge features contemporary Canadian design and artwork, including a quiet business zone equipped with flatscreen desktop computers, RICOH colour printing and scanning, and a custom-crafted maple-wood work table by Duncan, BC's Live Edge Design. Complimentary Wi-Fi and power sources are available throughout. Customers can enjoy hot and cold dining options, a chef's station for individually prepared dishes, and wines from Canada and around the world. The lounge also features spa-inspired shower rooms with rain-shower heads, a TV zone, a VIP room and a quiet zone with reclining chairs.

AIR CANADA STOPOVER

Connecting in Toronto, Montreal or Vancouver during your flight?

With Air Canada Stopover, you can enjoy a relaxing hotel stay and discover a great Canadian city while you're at it – all with no additional airline fees. Air Canada Stopovers are offered as part of any itinerary that includes a connection time of more than six hours between consecutive flights—opt in at any time up until 96 hours before your flight's scheduled departure time. You will receive one night's hotel accommodation starting at \$49* if you're travelling on an Economy Basic, Standard, Flex or comfort fare, or free or reduced rate accommodations if you're flying in Economy Latitude, Premium Economy, Business Class or Air Canada Signature Class.

To book an Air Canada Stopover, select "Air Canada Stopover" from the travel options offered once you've selected your flight, or ask your travel agent to add it in to your itinerary. If you've already booked a flight and want to add an Air Canada Stopover, retrieve your booking on aircanada.com and click the link to opt in. You then have until 96 hours prior to your arrival in your connecting city (Toronto, Montreal or Vancouver) to book your hotel.

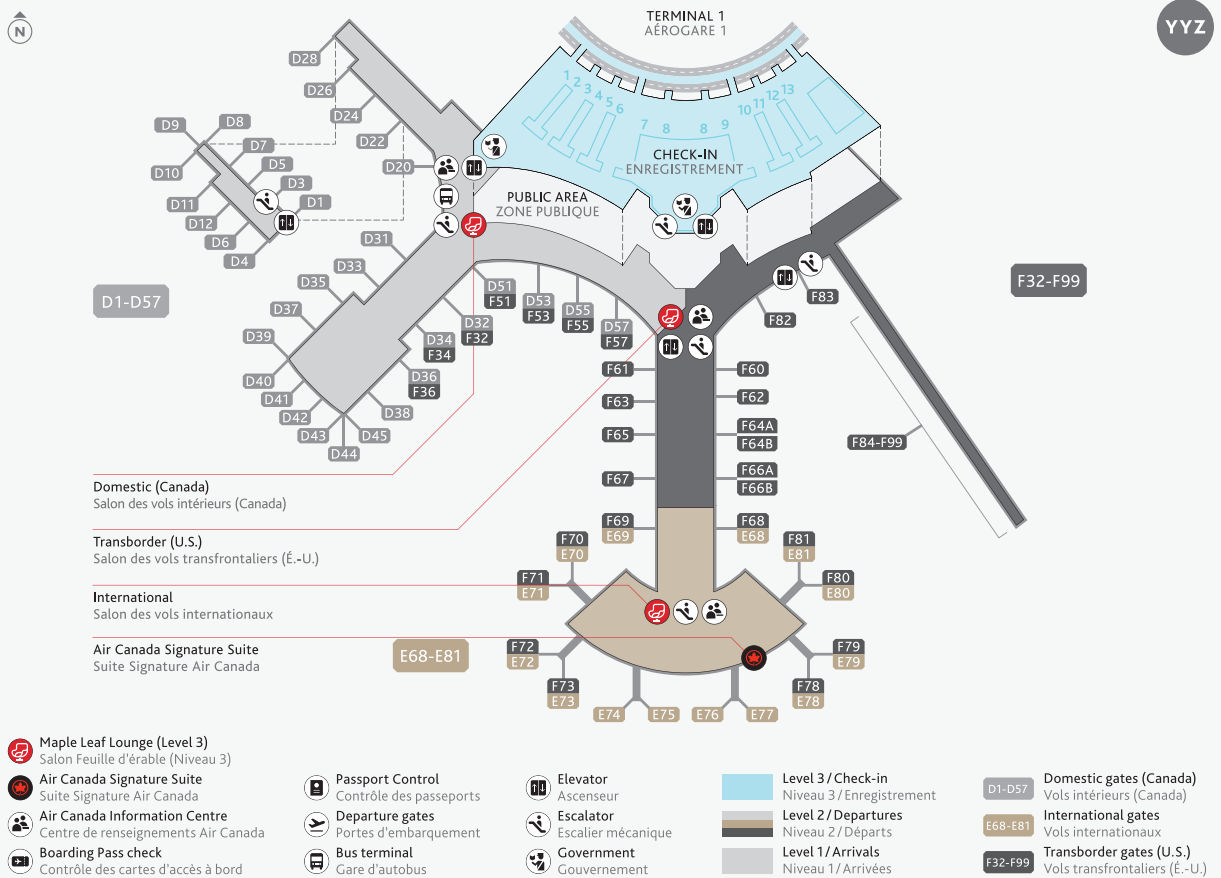
We're proud to be the first airline in North America to guarantee this service to select customers travelling in a premium cabin and we plan to extend it to other customers in the future.

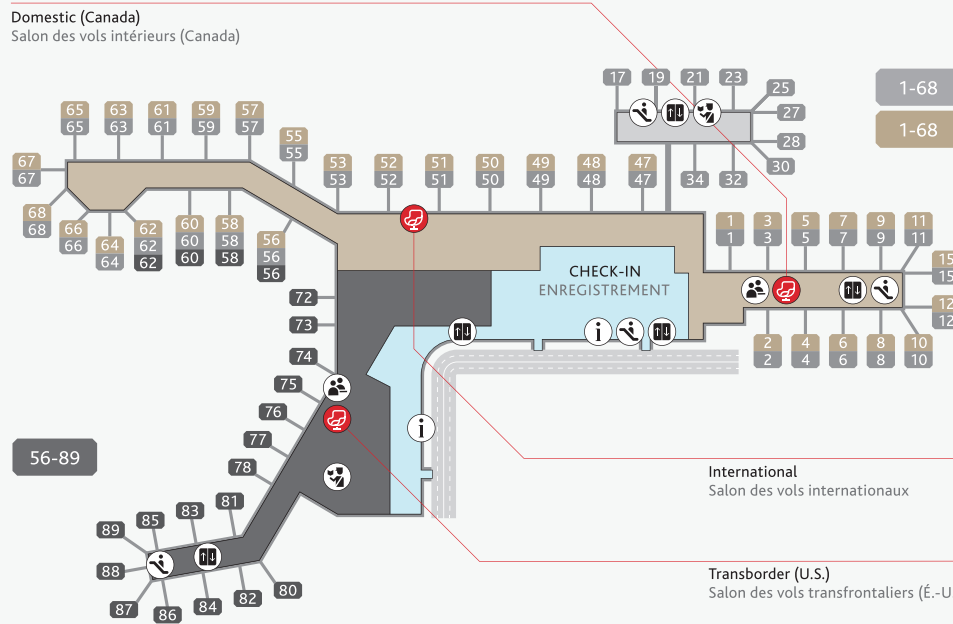

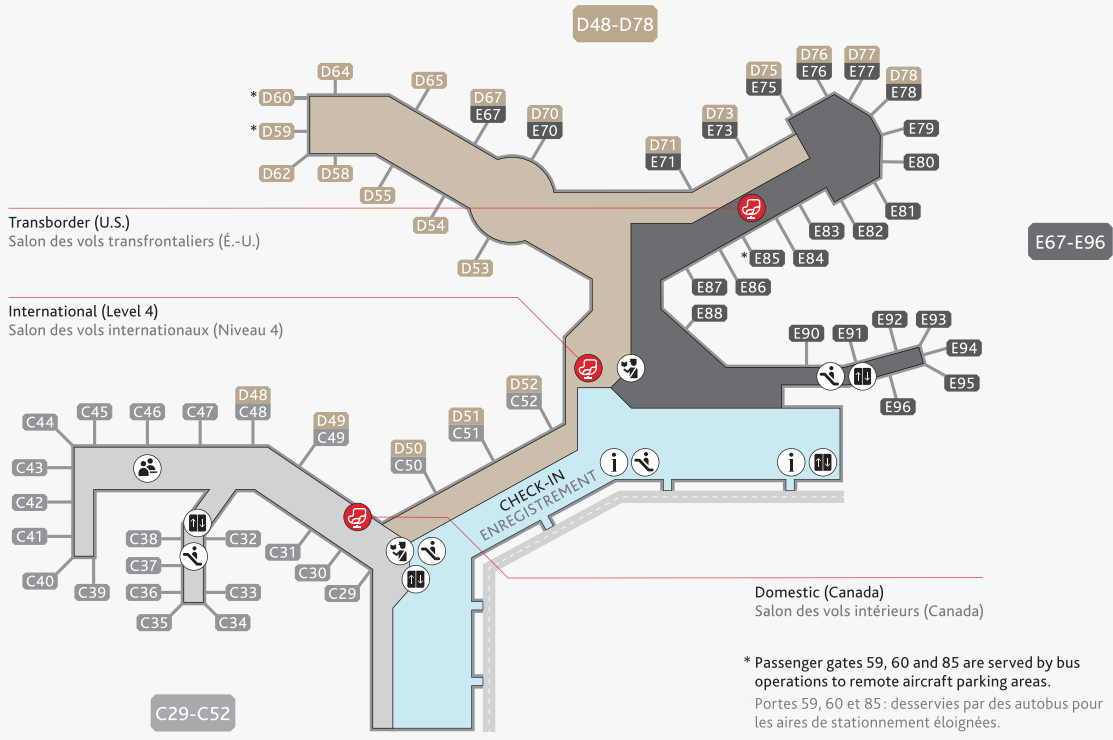
